Discipline Policy

We are using a school-wide discipline model based on the preventative approach. Students are made clearly aware of the fact that they are totally responsible for their own behavior.

- A. Prevention
 - 1. Love and accept the learner unconditionally.
 - 2. Expectations should be clearly communicated to the students, (i.e. no running in hallway, use inside voice in the classroom and cafeteria, be kind in words and deeds.)
 - 3. Be realistic and consistent in both love and discipline.
 - 4. Recognize and reward positive student actions.

- B. Correction
 - 1. Have the student to state what the inappropriate behavior was.
 - 2. Conference with the student to be sure he/she understands what was inappropriate
 - 3. Without favoritism, administer consequences fairly in dealing with students individually.

- C. Determine Consequences
 - 1. Define the inappropriate behavior
 - 2. Choose the best solution to address it.
 - a. Give the child a firm talk in private.
 - b. Separate the child from the group.
 - c. Take away various privileges.
 - d. Document above incidents.
 - 1. If misbehavior continues, a parent/student/teacher conference is required.
 - 2. If the misbehavior continues, the parent/guardian is required to conference with the teacher and administration to determine the child's continued enrollment at Glendale Christian Academy.

The first two weeks of school will be structured to emphasize appropriate academy conduct.
